Today is the third Sunday of Advent. We are in the middle of a short series called **Christmas Road Trip**. Each week, we are looking at the amazing story of God's entering a broken world through Jesus, and we are doing this by thinking about travel. The original Christmas included all kinds of travel-Joseph, Mary, wise men, shepherds, angels, and more. God's Incarnation in his Son Jesus Christ is a long and winding road trip through history. and we will be thinking about some of these road stops each Sunday, Today we pull over in the tiny Galilean village of Nazareth and listen in as a very young girl gets a very startling message from a now-familiar angel: Road to Nazareth. Our worship leader today is Eric Lemmons.
