We continue our series Thorns: Finding God in Pain. Today, let's talk about anger. To many of us, anger doesn't seem very virtuous, does it? It is certainly painful and real. In Ephesians 4:25-5:2, Paul writes to real people living in real community and experiencing real discord. Oddly enough, he doesn't seem to give a hoot about "being nice." What he does care about is our loving one another. Anger is actually a part of healthy relationship, but for Christians it has to be managed in the name of Jesus. Today, let's rethink and reclaim anger as something good: Fighting the Good Fight. Our worship leader is Mark Tate.
