The UCC elders held their **monthly meeting** with ministry staff on July 26, 2018. There were a number of items discussed and prayed over this month, among them:

- 1. Prayed, by name, for those who are in the hospital/skilled nursing, for those battling cancer and dementia, prayers of rejoicing with **Ted and Heather Moreno** on the birth of their son, **Judson,** for those who have placed membership with our family, and for many others;
- 2. **Grateful for the good news** from our recent youth mission trip, Terrific Tuesdays with our younger kids, all of the good things that have happened and continue to happen in our summer mission efforts, and Hal's prison report that thus far in 2018 there have been 357 baptisms at the prison;
- 3. Read reports from **Vini, Bradley, and Brent** discussing proposed new events that will help bring our men closer together, beginning in the fall;
- 4. Discussed the effectiveness of **Common Life Groups** and tabled any action to a later date;
- 5. Approved a plan from the **Buildings and Grounds Committee** to spend funds (\$13,000 \$15,000) from savings to install additional security cameras and additional server upgrades to handle all of our security cameras;
- 6. Discussed and voted on a few requests from the worship committee;
- 7. As we concluded our meeting Brent prayed over Ted Presley and Tim Archer, and for their fellow teammates, as they were all leaving for **Cuba** the following morning for 10 days;
- 8. Set the **next meeting** for August 19th.

As always, the UCC elders are grateful for each of you and covet your continued prayers, just as we remember you in our prayers.
